Philadelphia

To the angel of the church in Philadelphia write:

These are the words of him who is holy and true, who holds the key of David. What he opens no one can shut, and what he shuts no one can open. 8 I know your deeds. See, I have placed before you an open door that no one can shut. I know that you have little strength, yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name. 9 I will make those who are of the synagogue of Satan, who claim to be Jews though they are not, but are liars—I will make them come and fall down at your feet and acknowledge that I have loved you. 10 Since you have kept my command to endure patiently, I will also keep you from the hour of trial that is going to come on the whole world to test the inhabitants of the earth.

11 I am coming soon. Hold on to what you have, so that no one will take your crown. 12 The one who is victorious I will make a pillar in the temple of my God. Never again will they leave it. I will write on them the name of my God and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which is coming down out of heaven from my God; and I will also write on them my new name. 13 Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

The Bible Story: God Made a Covenant with David

Bible Passage: 2 Samuel 7

The Main Point: God promised that Jesus would come from David's family.

The Big Picture Question: Who is our king? Jesus is our King forever, and he rules over the world.

Christ Connection: God promised David that every future king of Israel would come from David's family, and David's kingdom would last forever. God kept His promise by sending His Son, Jesus, to be one of David's descendants.

Jesus is our King who will rule over God's people forever.

July Memory Verse: Psalm 83:18 "Let them know that you, whose name is the Lord- that you alone are the Most High over all the earth."

Family Discussion Starters:

- Why did David want to build a temple for God?
- Why do you think God stopped David from building a temple?
- How do you think David felt, knowing about God's promise to send the Messiah through David's family?
- **Family Activity:** Work with your kids to do some research about your family tree. Pray for the family members that don't know Jesus.
